Electronic Device Contract**

**Bring this form, completed and signed to Girls State Registration**

Girls State Delegates will be allowed to bring their electronic devices (with your permission) to Girls State. Both the delegate and parents must sign this form attesting to your full understanding of our electronic device policy and the action taken in case there is a violation to the policy.

- 1.) You may bring electronic devices to Girls State. Electronic devices (not including cameras) may be used in the dorm ONLY. Computers will be made available to any delegate in the event they don't bring their own.
- 2.) Please note that if you bring a laptop it may only be use to draft bills and prepare speeches. They may not be used for creating campaign materials or accessing the internet (internet service is not available to us on campus).
- 3.) Any delegate bringing an electronic device(s) to Girls State must register their device(s) using this form.
- 4.) Electronic devices (with the exception of cameras) are not allowed at the Capitol at any time (Please refer to Capitol Policy hand out).
- 5.) Your electronic devices must remain in the dorm at all times. It is your responsibility to lock your belongings in your dorm room prior to leaving your city.
- 6.) Any violation of this electronic device contract will result in the device being taken for the remainder of the program. Devices will be stored in the Director's office until the conclusion of the program prior to boarding the busses to go home. Please be aware that all staff members have the authority to enforce this policy.
- 7.) Neither the American Legion Auxiliary, Department of Florida nor Florida Girls State will assume any responsibility for the safe keeping of phones brought by delegates. Our Insurance will not cover their damage or loss.

Telephone Contract**

Girls State Delegates will be allowed to bring their cell phones (with your permission) to Girls State. Both the delegate and parents must sign this form attesting to your full understanding of our phone policies and the action taken in case there is a violation to the policy. We encourage all delegates to call home on a daily basis. Be assured that if you do not hear from them at a scheduled time they will call you as time permits as we have a very busy schedule.

Please remember that Girls State is an intense study of government and distractions (especially cell phones) can cause a disruption the program. The policy on phone use during our program is very strict. Phones will be made available to any delegate in the event they don't bring their own. Free time is noted on the daily schedule and cities will establish nighttime phone usage ordinance as part of their self-government.

- 1.) Delegates bringing a cell phone to Girls State must register their phone using this form.
- 2.) The use of phones on campus is limited to INSIDE THE DORM ONLY.
- 3.) All phones will be turned OFF (not on silent or vibrate) during program time and only used during free time as indicated in their schedule. Please note that the schedule is subject to change.
- 4.) Phones are not allowed at the Capitol at any time (Please refer to Capitol Policy hand out).
- 5.) Any violation of this phone contract will result in the phone being taken for the remainder of the program. Phones will be stored in the Director's office until the conclusion of the program prior to boarding the busses to go home. Please be aware that all staff members have the authority to enforce this policy.
- 6.) Neither the American Legion Auxiliary, Department of Florida nor Florida Girls State will assume any responsibility for the safe keeping of phones brought by delegates. Our Insurance will not cover their damage or loss.
