

Florida American Legion Auxiliary Girls State College Scholarship

A full "Two plus Two" College Scholarship to attend two years at Tallahassee Community College followed by two years at Florida State University.

A Full College Scholarship

Tallahassee Community College and Florida State University offer the Girls State Scholarship as a cooperative effort in recognition of outstanding leadership at the American Legion Auxiliary's Girls State program in Tallahassee. There will be a total of five scholarships awarded.

A "Two plus Two" Scholarship

This scholarship includes an award of a full tuition scholarship at Tallahassee Community College and one hundred dollars per semester for the purchase of books.

Following the completion of an Associate's Degree at T.C.C., with a 3.0 GPA the student will be awarded \$2,400 per year (\$1,200 per semester) for up to four semesters to attend Florida State University. There will be no book stipend.

Applying for this scholarship in no way obligates the student to attend these two institutions; but if the student is selected, the scholarship can only be used at Tallahassee Community College and Florida State University.

Criteria for Scholarships

Criteria used to award these scholarships will be based solely on the applicant's letter of intent and more significantly, the girl's performance and quality of participation in the Girls State session. Participation and performance will be measured by active involvement in the legislative process during the week at Girls State. Including running for state office, and the outstanding performance on the exam given at the end. It is only through the cooperative efforts of the Tallahassee Community College, Florida State University, and the American Legion Auxiliary that these scholarships are made possible.

Application Procedure

This scholarship is available to all delegates attending the American Legion Auxiliary's Girls State program in Tallahassee, Florida. Delegates interested in making themselves eligible must:

1. Complete the *Authorization of Intent* form.
2. Attach a one-page letter explaining; "How this scholarship will help me achieve my academic goals."

This statement should include a brief description of the student's academic plans and how they will relate to future career choices. Any unique challenges or circumstances relevant to the pursuit of those academic goals would be well worth noting.

The one page, typed, statement must be attached to the *Authorization of Intent* sheet and **turned in at Registration** on June 25, 2014.
